

Is freelance work too unstable for you? Do you like benefits? Still want to grow your income beyond the price cap of a graphic designer longer term?




Another option for income growth is to take your design skills and translate them to a relatable field with some additional training.




# Gaining Years of Experience and Social Proof

Time and good reviews can help you slowly inch up your prices beyond in-house or salaried levels.



### **Expanding Beyond the Basics**

Go beyond just simple design projects and expand into brand design and marketing strategy (just one example).

Not everyone's timeline is exactly the same, but almost everyone's timeline trends upward with experience and social proof.

It can take some time to establish yourself as a freelancer. Learning new software, tricks, styles, reading books and just practicing can all be considered some form of experience.

#### \$10,000 - In-Demand

My logo design process now is only offered with full branding packages. I was so much in-demand that I had to raise prices to keep my work flow reasonable.

#### \$500 - Credibility

I used prior case studies to land larger clients. Client referrals were starting to come in. My system became more refined.

#### Ac- --- 11

Not getting a lot of work, so keep doing practice projects.

#### \$25 - Flat-line Not getting a lot of \$100 - Average

Average work got average rates. There is still so much more to learn about this software.

#### \$2,000 - Established

With several years of logo design projects under my belt I felt confident in offering much higher pricing. I had prior client testimonials to prove value.




