

Filter by TCP or UDP port

1. Match by a single port

Match option: **-p tcp --dport** port, **-p udp --sport** port

Example:

```
iptables -A INPUT -p tcp --dport 22 -j DROP
```

2. Match by multiple ports

Match option: **-m multiport --sports | --dports** port1,port2,...

Example:

```
iptables -A OUTPUT -p tcp -m multiport --dports 80,443 -j ACCEPT
```

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More examples:

1. Block all incoming traffic to port 80
2. Permit ssh incoming traffic only from a specific ip address
3. Block ports 80 and 443 using *'-m multiport'*
