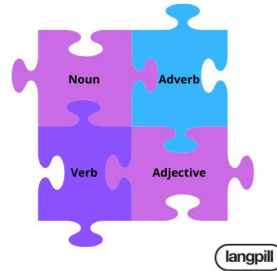

Parts of a Sentence - Prepositions

What are prepositions?

Prepositions are words that we use to show the relationship between other words. They give us information about time, location, or movement.

The dog runs **down** the street.

The dog runs **on** the street.

Parts of a Sentence - Prepositions

Prepositional Phrase

A prepositional phrase is a preposition with the object it belongs to.

The dog runs **down** the street.

down the street

The dog runs **on** the street.

on the street

Parts of a Sentence - Prepositions

Types of Prepositions

Time (when)
I start school **in** September.

Place (where)
She jumped **on** the table.

Movement (how)
He walks **to** work.

- In, to, and on are very common prepositions. However, there are many more.

I swim at night

at - Time (when)

Put the shoes in the box.

in - Place (where)

Lean the box towards the wall.

towards - Movement (how)
