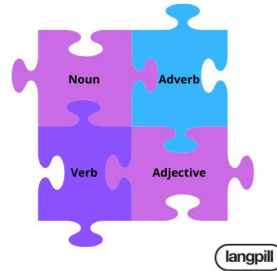


PARTS OF A SENTENCE - NOUNS



Parts of a Sentence - Nouns

What is a Noun?

A **noun** is a person, place, or thing.

The **dog** runs down the **street**.

Both **dog** and **street** are nouns.

Parts of a Sentence - Nouns

Noun Categories

Person	Place	Thing	Animal	Feeling
fireman, bus driver, man	New York America space	pencil, apple, desk	dog, bird, cat	Love, hate, anger

Parts of a Sentence - Nouns

Singular or Plural

Singular	Plural	Rule
Apple	Apples	Add 's'
Fox	Foxes	Add 'es'
Cherry	Cherries	Drop 'y' and add 'ies'

Parts of a Sentence - Nouns

English - Parts of a Sentence Course

Common, Proper, or Pronoun

Common	proper	pronouns
man	George Washington	He
woman	Cleopatra	she

Parts of a Sentence - Nouns

English - Parts of a Sentence Course

Examples

The man walked to the store and met President Obama.

Man (common, singular), **store** (common, singular), **President Obama** (proper, singular)

The turtles ate carrots. They were full of happiness.

Turtles (common, plural), **carrots** (common, plural), **they** (pronoun, plural), **happiness** (common, singular)
