PASSIVE INFORMATION GATHERING

- Collection of information about a specific target without the analyst's activities being minimally detected by the target.
- Difficult to carry out and often yields inconclusive results.
- The usual method of passive information gathering is through access to information stored in public places.
- It is rarely used individually.
